These instructions describe how to prepare and submit an abstract for reviewing and publishing in the abstract book of the NLPM 2006.

Your conference abstract should be prepared using LATEX and submitted before 15 March 2006. Please send the abstract as the body of your email to "NLPM06@ilt.kharkov.ua". The subject line should contain the words "NLPM06 abstract".

The abstract should fit into one page. The text height, from the top of the title line to the bottom of the last line, must not exceed 25 cm.

The abstract should strictly follow the instructions given in the template. Please do not use other style files or exotic fonts. The abstract should be informative and not only indicate the general scope of the presentation but also state the main results obtained and conclusions drawn. The abstract should be complete in itself.

You may use formulas and references in your abstract. The way of adding the bibliography should strictly follow the given example [1, 2, 3]. Please do not use other styles or commands. We intend to reproduce the abstracts at 70 percent of this size, which might be good to know if you have very fine indices or details in formulas.
